Inpatient Psychiatry

Our 51-bed inpatient unit offers comprehensive programs that serve children ages 7-17 by providing acute crisis management, comprehensive psychiatric assessment, medication management, and support for families to obtain appropriate outpatient services.

During any hospital stay, the child can expect to receive:

- A multidisciplinary assessment
- Individualized care plan
- •Evidence-based medication management
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- Music and recreational therapy
- Ongoing, collaborative postdischarge planning from first day of admission
- Consultation with pediatric specialists as needed
